RING SIZE GUIDE

This guide is designed to be used with an existing ring to find your ring size.
To ensure greatest accuracy use a ring with a similar band with and style to what you want to buy

























Step 1

Print this guide at 100%.In the print dialogue, check that scaling is set to 'default' or 'none'. You can check that the page has printed correctly by placing a credit card in the box to the right. Alternatively, you could measure the width of the box, which should be exactly 8.6cm.



Step 2

Place your ring on the chart below and match the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. The letter that fits best within the circle, is your ring size. If the ring falls between two sizes, then you should pick the larger size.
